

These bags will be given to the Directors in states that had a minimum of 15 AIM members in the 2017 target year. The Directors will then give the bag away with a shootoff by single number drawing at their AIM State Shoot. All 37 states must have an AIM State Shoot to be eligible. These bags have the Embossed Scroll Pattern and AIM logo on them and can hold eight shell boxes. The retail value of each bag is \$155.

ATTENTION SHOOTERS:

All ATA and ISTA fees and targets are subject to county 1% and state 6% sales tax(7%). AIM target price is \$27.10@100 targets x 7% sales tax = \$29.00 as listed in the program.

By entering the grounds everyone agrees to abide by the all the ATA rules.

No pets are allowed in the club house. All pets must be leashed during the shoot. Pets be attached to one end of the leash and a human to the other end of the leash.

No smoking in any building, tent or awning of a building.

Check your score sheets on each position change. Know what a scored dead looks like.

Check the score board/TVs for errors. Errors will be corrected upon discovery.

AIM special categories must be declared at entry.

Bring your average card and have it averaged.

Be ready to shoot. Squads will not wait for tarty members. If you miss your squad, we will help you make up or resquad.

Management my change the order of squads for any reason.

Do not ask or allow yourself to be squaded in the last squad of a first event and the first squad of a following event. We may not stop between events, there-for you will not make your next event.

Practice is available before the events on any second bank. Practice is honor system.

100 straight patches and pins are available at the sign up building.

No prizes will be shipped. You or your representative may pick them up anytime up to one year anniversary of the event.

We are not responsible for accidents, theft, or the weather.

We may alter the program due to conditions beyond our control.

Entries and options can be refunded as long as you didn't shoot.

No golf carts allowed north of the main sidewalk. No golf carts allowed on the sidewalk during the events.

When it is your turn, close your gun so that the gun is not aiming at any of the voice release equipment. Cords are \$75.00 and the control box is \$500.00. You shoot a cord or box you own it.

Ear and eye protection required and open or out is enforced along with all other safety rules are enforced.

Management has the right to balance the fields at anytime.

No guns or gun cases in the main brick clubhouse.

Please tell the area business you are here for the shoot.

CLASSIFICATION FOR INDIVIDUALS

SINGLES

Classes within each category will be used for the Online Zone Championship and the AIM Grand National Singles Championship. Singles classes for each age category are as follows:

In the current target year, the target requirement to avoid **minimum** Class B for any age category will be 200 ATA Registered Singles targets prior to the Online Zone Championship and 400 ATA Registered Singles targets prior to the AIM Grand National Championship.

DOUBLES

Doubles classification will be used for the AIM Grand National Individual Doubles Championship. In the current target year, the target requirement to avoid **minimum** Class B for any age category will be 200 ATA Registered Doubles targets prior to the event. The following classes will be used for all age categories:

Class A 82% - 100% Class B 70% - 81,99% Class C Under 70%

HANDICAP

There will be no target requirements or penalty yardage for the AIM Grand National Individual Handicap Championship. Members will compete from their current ATA vardage.

CLASSIFICATION FOR SQUAD - SINGLES EVENTS

SQUAD CATEGORY

Shooters may shoot on a squad composed of members of other categories. However, the squad will be shooting in the highest category represented in the squad. Example: If a squad is comprised of 1 Pre-Sub, 2 Sub-Juniors and 2 Juniors, the squad will be competing in the Junior category. Moving up in age group is for squad purposes only and does not affect a shooters individual category with AIM.

Squads are defined as five (5) shooters competing on the same squad, at the same registered shoot, at the same gun club, and on the same trap field. There are no exceptions to this rule.

SQUAD/TEAM CLASS (Online Zone Championship & AIM Grand Championships Only)

Using the individual classification table found on the previous page, Singles squad classification will be based upon the composite average of the five shooters on the squad. The following classes will be used for penalty classified shooters:

Iowa State Aim Championship information

AIM Shooters will compete for AIM Championship medals in Singles, Handicap and Doubles on Saturday. The shoot will start at 10:00AM with registration and squading open at 8:00AM at the sign up building. There will be medals for non-lowa residents also. Check www.stockdalegunclub.com website for presquading.

Shooters are required to have current 2018 ATA, AIM and lowa residents must have memberships paid prior to the shoot. Non-residents do not need ISTA membership.

Mixed age group squads are allowed to compete but will compete in the category of the oldest AIM member shooting on the squad. If you presquad, be sure you squad with the four other members of your team. You are not required to presquad.

Ties for AIM awards are not settled by shoot offs. They are resolved by reverse score by sub-event.

Shamrock Leathers has again graciously donated an 8 box leather bag to the lowa State AIM Shoot program. The bag will be awarded by a lucky number (0-9) drawing at the end of the singles event; each lucky number will shoot off for the bag. The shoot off will be a "turkey shoot" type event. All shooters will shoot one target from the 16 yard line per post, then one per post from the 22 yard line, then one target per post from the 27 yardline, high score. If still tied, ties will be shot off miss and out by repeating at the 27 yardline.

Please plan to attend Friday. We will be running practice traps and marathon type ATA registered targets as a preliminary warm up to Saturday's event. At the end of the day approximately 6:00PM we will have a cook out for all contestants and their guests.


