



#### MEMBERSHIP FEES: \$25

The total fee for any eligible ATA member to participate in AIM is \$25. All AIM members must be ATA members first. ATA annual membership for those 22 and under is \$12 and AIM membership is \$13. All AIM membership fees are applied to AIM program costs (awards, scholarships and promotion of youth shooting). All AIM members are eligible to participate in any ATA registered event or tournament, including the Grand American, throughout the year.

New members in ATA & AIM will receive a new member packet after payment is received. This packet will include: two (2) orange AIM membership cards(one for the coach/parent and one for the shooter), an average card, and other general information.

Renewing members, who have not signed up for the online average card, will receive a new average card annually. Those that have signed up for the online average card can print off their updated card as often as they would like. 

#### TARGET YEAR: SEPTEMBER 1ST, 2018 - AUGUST 31ST, 2019

New Members - Age category is based on your age the day you join the ATA. Renewing Members - Age category is based on your age as of 9-1-2018. Shooters who become eligible for new age based categories during the target year may elect to continue to compete in the previous category for the remainder of that target year. (For example, a shooter reaching age 18 may elect to continue to shoot as a Junior for the remainder of the current target year.) However, once a shooter has elected to move to the new category, that decision is irrevocable and he/she may not again declare eligibility for the previous category. <u>ALL</u> mid-year category changes must be submitted to the ATA office within 7 business days of the shooter's birthday by calling 618-449-2224 or emailing aim@shootata.com.


#### AVERAGE CARDS

When making entry at any registered shoot, shooters should provide their plastic identification card and average card so that names, addresses, and membership numbers are properly noted and errors in record keeping are prevented. Average cards must be filled out to provide classification personnel at registered shoots with current data on a member's shooting ability. It is the shooter's responsibility to keep their average cards filled out and up-to-date. Average cards can be printed off of *www.shootata.com* at any time. 

# 2019 AIM IOWA STATE SHOOT

#### SQUAD CATEGORY

Shooters may shoot on a squad composed of members of other categories. However, the squad will be shooting in the highest category represented in the squad. Example: If a squad is comprised of 1 Pre-Sub, 2 Sub-Juniors and 2 Juniors, the squad will be competing in the Junior category. Moving up in age group is for squad purposes only and does not affect a shooters individual category with AIM.

Squads are defined as five (5) shooters competing on the same squad, at the same registered shoot, at the same gun club, and on the same trap field. There are no exceptions to this rule.



#### ATTENTION EVERYONE:

All ATA and ISTA fees and targets are subject to county 1% and state 6% sales tax(7%). AIM target price is 28.040@100 targets x 7% sales tax = 30.00 as listed in the program.

By entering the grounds everyone agrees to abide by the all the ATA rules. No pets are allowed in the club house. All pets must be leashed during the shoot. Pets be attached to one end of the leash and a human to the other end of the leash. No smoking in any building, tent or awning of a building.

Check your score sheets on **each position change**. Know what a scored dead target looks like on the score sheet.

Check the score board/TVs for errors. Errors will be corrected upon discovery. AIM special categories must be declared at entry.

Bring your average card and have it averaged.

Be ready to shoot. Squads will not wait for tarty members. If you miss your squad, we will help you make up or resquad.

Management my change the order of squads for any reason.

Do not ask or allow yourself to be squaded in the last squad of a first event and the first squad of a following event. We may not stop between events, there-for you will not make your next event.

Practice is available before the events on any second bank. Practice is honor system.

25, 50, 75 & 100 straight patches and 100 pins are available at the sign up building. No prizes will be shipped. You or your representative may pick them up anytime up to one year anniversary of the event.

We are not responsible for accidents, theft, or the weather.

We may alter the program due to conditions beyond our control.

Entries and options can be refunded as long as you didn't shoot.

No golf carts allowed north of the main sidewalk. No golf carts allowed on the sidewalk during the events.

When it is your turn, close your gun so that the gun is not aiming at any of the voice release equipment. Cords are \$75.00 and the control box is \$500.00. You shoot a cord or box you own it.

Ear and eye protection required and open or out is enforced along with all other safety rules are enforced.

Management has the right to balance the fields at anytime.

No guns or gun cases in the main brick clubhouse.

Please tell the area business you are here for the shoot.

# 2019 AIM IOWA STATE SHOOT

#### Iowa State Aim Championship information

AIM Shooters will compete for AIM Championship medals in Singles, Handicap and Doubles on Saturday. The shoot will start at 10:00AM with registration and squading open at 8:00AM at the sign up building. There will be medals for non-lowa residents also. Check www.stockdalegunclub.com website for pre-sqauding.

Morning practice is available at any trap that is set beginning at 8:00AM. Practice is 6.00 per round of 25. Practice and camping is the honor system. Payment in the sign up building. After the events begin a dedicated practice trap is at the west end of the grounds.

Shooters are required to have current 2019 ATA, AIM and Iowa residents must have memberships paid prior to the shoot. Non-residents do not need ISTA membership.

Mixed age group squads are allowed to compete but will compete in the category of the oldest AIM member shooting on the squad. If you presquad, be sure you squad with the four other members of your team. You are not required to presquad.

Ties for AIM awards are not settled by shoot offs. They are resolved by reverse score by sub-event.

Please plan to attend Friday. We will be running practice traps and marathon ATA registered targets as a preliminary warm up to Saturday's event. At the end of the day approximately 6:00PM we will have a cook out for all contestants and their guests.

Friday's registered targets will be shot marathon style, 100 targets per trap.

Saturday's Iowa State AIM Championships will all be shot "Bank" style. Contestants will shoot 50 targets on their starting trap. The final 50 targets will be shot on the next field.
