



Welcome to the 2020 League and practice at the Stockdale Gun Club.

We greatly appreciate your support and trust. In accordance with the CDC guidelines and state recommendations pertaining to COVID-19, we want to share with you important information about the Stockdale Gun Club.

Beginning May 5th, the Stockdale Gun Club is open for league and practice.

Our highest priority is the health and well-being of our visitors, customers, volunteers and employees. During this time, we remain diligent in taking steps to make your trap shooting visit as safe and enjoyable as possible.

According to State of Iowa recommendations:

The club house will remain closed. We recommend cashless entry. Sign-up will be conducted at the "closed pay-windows" of the sign-up building. Sign-up lines and score cards will be at six foot social distancing as in accordance with business guidelines. Please look down to the tape lines on the concrete. There are 5 shooters or less per squad, one squad per trap. No visitors are allowed to congregate on or near those shooting ranges while in use.

Please maintain distance.

Each trap range is at least 100 feet apart.

The closest distance between shooting stations (Posts) is 9 feet at the 16-yard line. One by one hand your score card to the referee. Total scores will be tabulated at the end evening event. Check your league scores on the monitors or on the Stockdale Gun Club website.

Pack your hand sanitizer.

There are no food or drinks available other than pop vending machines. We do have hand sanitizers available at the club There are port-a-pots available maintained with sanitizers by Cooley Pumping.

If you have been sick in the last two weeks, please stay at home for your health and the safety of others!

We are monitoring the situation.

We promise to remain diligent in protecting you and making your visit a great experience. As conditions change, so may our policies. We will keep you informed of any changes moving forward. League is great practiced for the state and regional meets, they are still coming. There is still a future.
