# WELCOME TO THE 10th ANNUAL HEARTLAND GRAND AMERICAN

The Executive Committee is pleased to present the program for the Heartland Grand American.

**Do not sign up in the last squads for a first event, then the first squads of the next event. You will not make it to your trap, even while we are changing trap ranges for doubles. We do not stop shooting between events.**

The Heartland Grand American is one of the first shoots of the new target year. Please have your ATA and state dues paid before entering the sign up lines at the shoot.

By entering the grounds everyone agrees to abide by all ATA rules.

Be ready to shoot, squads are not to wait for tardy members.

1) The Heartland Grand Tournament will start on Tuesday, August 29th at 11:00 AM.

a) Stockdale Gun Club will host all or a portion of all events.

b) Events 16, 19 & 22, the HAA and 8-10, 12-14, 16, 17, 19 & 22 the HOA, comprise the Heartland Grand.

2) Daily Fees - ATA \$3.00; ISTA \$3.00 will be charged, **plus 7% Iowa state sales tax (.50)**. All targets are subject to Iowa state sales tax. State sales tax is included in the daily target fees (**Target price is \$32.71 plus 7% Sales tax, equals \$35.00. Sub Jr., Jr. Gold& AIM target fees are \$27.10 plus 7% sales tax, equalling \$29.00**)

3) All singles and handicap shoot-offs will be on a 25-target basis and doubles will be on 10 pair. All singles carry-overs will be on a 25 target basis and doubles will be on a 50-target basis. HOA & HAA shoot off targets are 20 Singles, 10 Handicap, & 5 Pair of doubles.

4) You may use your own shells including reloads.

5) There are no compulsory purses.

6) Practice trap fees: 25 birds- \$6.00; 12 pair- \$6.00. Practice is the honor system, but please pay in advance at the sign up building. Practice trap is at the west end of the trap line.

7) The cashier, squadding, and classification windows will open each tournament day at 8:00 AM and close at 4:00 PM. Closing time on Monday, September 4th will be at 1:00 pm.

8) There will be Hall of Fame Contributor Awards in Monday's Handicap.

9) Officials of the ATA and/or the Executive Committee and gun club management will make all program interpretations.

10) A member of the Central Handicap Committee will supervise classification and handicapping.

11) RE-SQUADDING IS MANDATORY FOR THOSE WHO HAVE MORE THAN ONE SUB-EVENT TO MAKE-UP (\$25 RE-SQUADDING FEE).

12) Pre-squadding services are being offered this year. See pages 22-23 for details.

13) ALL EVENTS SHALL BE SHOT 5 TARGETS TO A POST, 25 TARGETS TO A TRAP. DOUBLES WILL BE SHOT 50 TARGETS PER TRAP, 5 pair per post.

14) THERE WILL BE UP TO A MAXIMUM OF 8 BANKS CONSISTING OF 2 TRAPS PER BANK.

**Banks will be rotated each day.** There will be a drawing made by the management at the sign up building around 5:00 PM in view of shooters for bank assignments for each day. These bank assignments will be posted the night before at the club houses, sign up building and around the trap line. If you sign up after the bank assignments have been posted, you must take a position on the first available squad. There will be no exception to this rule. Squads will be assigned to the first available bank that is able to accommodate squadding needs. **Club management reserves the right to balance the fields.**

Targets shall be reset only if they become illegal or appreciably vary from legal targets. The final decision as to whether or not a trap is to be reset shall be made by the Target Setting Committee.

- All Handicap winners, and category winners from events 2,6,9,14 & 17.
- Contestants will be shooting off in a 2 bird per post, shoot off from the contestant's yardage as of Sunday, September 3rd, for a new TV. This is not miss & out, but events of 10.
- Once you are in the shoot off, your name cannot be drawn again. Once your in the shoot off by winning a handicap or category, the next high name will then be added.
- Shoot off will be shot in waves. Waves determined by number of shoot off traps available and determined by the 1<sup>st</sup> call though 3rd call to shoot off sign in order. Check score board for trap assignment.

# SHOOTER'S RESPONSIBILITY

## ENTRY AND SHOOTING PROCEDURE

- 1) **THIS IS A 2018 TARGET YEAR EVENT. PLEASE HAVE YOUR ATA & ISTA (Iowa Shooters Only) DUES PREPAID IN ADVANCE FOR THE 2018 TARGET YEAR.**
- 2) In all events that include class advances, all shooters (regardless of category) with scores that equal or exceed the score of the class champion will be advanced starting with the next like event.
- 3) Take your average card to the classification desk. Do not attempt to make your program entries before doing so.
- 4) **BE SURE YOUR AVERAGE CARD IS UP TO DATE.** Be sure your classification and handicap yardage are marked plainly by a member of the handicap committee before you leave the table. It is your responsibility to know the rules. You are subject to penalties for shooting in the wrong classification or at the wrong yardage even if your card is so marked.
- 5) It is the responsibility of category shooters to see that they are so marked at the time they are classified/handicapped. If your special category does not appear on the bulletin sheet, report the omission at the cashier's office.
- 6) If you draw squad positions that will not be used for an event, please see our squadding personnel to release your position. Releasing your position allows us to fill holes in open squads, making this tournament more enjoyable for all shooters. **A shooter may not draw more than one (1) position per event.**
- 7) Squadding will be restricted to a maximum of 2 yards on a squad, or as ATA rule book states.
- 8) The cashier will accept no counter checks and the only type of cash or check accepted will be U.S. funds. Checks will be accepted for the amount of shooting fees only - No Exceptions.
- 9) No additions or withdrawals permitted on purses and options. **NO OPTIONS REFUNDED UNLESS EVENT IS CANCELLED.**
- 10) If you sign up after the bank assignments have been posted, you must take a position on the first available squad. There will be no exception to this rule. Squads will be assigned to the first available bank that is able to accommodate squadding needs. Club management reserves the right to balance the fields.
- 11) Classification and Squadding/Cashiering will open:  
Open Tuesday through Sunday – 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM and  
Monday, September 4 - 9:00 AM to 1:00 PM.
- 12) Payoff checks may be picked up at the trophy counter.
- 13) Please do not wait until the last day to receive your added money, payoff checks and trophies.
- 14) **MAKE YOUR CAMPING RESERVATIONS FOR THE 2019 AT THE TROPHY COUNTER.**

# NOTICES

## **SOLICITING**

No soliciting, selling chances, taking entries for splatter board shoots or similar activities will be allowed on the grounds, nor shall any literature of any kind be distributed on the grounds without prior written approval by the ATA and club

## **GAMBLING**

Gambling is not permitted on the club grounds at any time.

## **SHELLS**

Sale of shells or components by anyone other than the club is prohibited.

## **ANNOUNCEMENT**

This program will absolutely govern the Tournament. The Amateur Trapshooting Association rules will govern all points not otherwise provided for. The Executive Committee reserves the absolute right, in its sound discretion, at any time prior to or during this Tournament to change or modify this program in any manner it desires.

## **CLASSIFICATION**

Shooters are required to have their 16-yard and doubles averages computed for use by the handicap committee.

## **SINGLES AND DOUBLES SHOOT-OFFS**

Singles event carry over 1 to 5, 5 to 8, 8 to 13, 13 to 19, & 18 to 19

Doubles events carry over event 3 to 4, 4 to 10, 10 to 12, 12 to 16

Shoot-offs will be shot on well lit traps using all white White Flyer Targets!

# **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

1) Should you win or tie for high in a class in any 16 yard or doubles event or earn yardage in any handicap event, it shall be your responsibility to report to the handicap desk and have your yardage increased or classification reviewed. Shooters winning or tying for high in class in event #8 and #10 will be advanced at least one class for the next like event. Any shooter whose class or yardage is changed for any reason shall be considered to be notified when the new class or yardage is posted on the bulletin board. In all events that include class advances all shooters (regardless of category) with scores that equal or exceed the score of the class champion will be advanced starting with the next like event.

2) Any shooter failing to carry out rule 1 above or who shoots in an incorrect class or from a yardage higher or lower than that assigned by the handicap committee will be subject to disqualification and will not be eligible to share in any money division or be eligible for trophies.

3) A shooter may not win more than one trophy in the same event. If a shooter's score qualifies for more than one trophy, the shooter must notify the shoot management which trophy they desire to take or shoot-off for. Failure of the shooter to make notification within 15 minutes of that event's last scores being posted imposes on shoot management the duty to make the determination for the shooter. Concurrent special awards are exempt from this rule.

4) At all tournaments where All American points will be awarded, in any event, Shooters may declare only one (1) Category (i.e., Lady I, Lady II, Junior Gold, Junior, Sub-Junior, Sub Veteran, Veteran, Senior Veteran ). Any shooter who is tied for event Champion may shoot-off/carry-over for the Championship trophy. If a shooter fails in the Championship trophy shoot-off/carry-over and has declared a Special Category, at classification, the shooter will fall back to his/her declared category. Any shooter who has declared a Special Category at Classification and whose score only qualifies him/her for any trophy in his/her declared Category will compete for the Category trophy and not for place, class or yardage group. Any Category shooter whose score doesn't qualify for a trophy in his/her Category may compete for place, class or yardage group.

5) Rule 3 above does not affect the right of all eligible shooters from shooting off for event champion or place trophies. A special category shooter may enter into a shoot off for event champion only and if unsuccessful fall back to special category.

6) Any special category declaration is to be made at the time you are classified. For purposes of special category declaration the time of entry is when you are classified. Report special category omission on the bulletin sheets to the cashier's office.

7) Each shooter who is entitled to receive money won during any event agrees that if such money is not received by him during the period of this tournament, a check in payment for the money won may be mailed to him at the address indicated by ATA records, and when so mailed, the club will not be liable in any manner whatsoever for any check lost, stolen, unclaimed or otherwise not received by the shooter.

8) Management will not be responsible for errors in scores after the options have been posted. Shooter should use the electronic bulletin board and the score board to check their scores to notify shoot management immediately if a discrepancy is noticed. **Errors will be corrected upon discovery.**

9) Shooters who do not have a total of 500 16 yard targets registered with the ATA in the current and previous year will be advanced at least two classes or more at the discretion of the classification committee. Shooters without an established average shall be placed in class B or higher at the discretion of the classification committee.

10) Shooters who do not have a total of 500 doubles targets registered with the ATA in the current and previous year will be advanced at least two classes or more at the discretion of the classification committee. Shooters without an established average shall be placed in class b or higher at the discretion of the classification committee.

11) Assigned yardage applies during this tournament. Shooters who do not have a total of 1000 handicap targets registered with the ATA in the current and previous year will be assigned to the 23 yard line or their regular handicap yardage, whichever is greater. Handicap target requirements will be waived for declared Senior-Vets, making them eligible for trophies and monies. Known ability may also be applied by the handicap committee. Shooters who fail to meet the minimum handicap target requirements as described above may shoot "targets only" from their assigned ATA yardage provided they waive and forfeit all right to options, purses, added money and trophies including HOA and HAA trophies.

12) All targets shot on Tuesday, August 30 and Wednesday, August 31st may be applied toward above target requirements. If target requirement is met, you must immediately return to the Handicap Desk and be re-classified. If requirements are not met, you will remain shooting assigned yardage and/or assigned classification. There will be no bump of classes on Tuesday or Wednesday.

13) In an effort to avoid unused positions, it is imperative that you either cashier or release all positions that you have squadded for prior to the event. **Anyone that does not cashier or release positions that have been squadded in their name will risk having any or all subsequent squadded positions in their name released by management.** You may call the office at (641) 648-4458 if you can not make it to the club in time and have your position released.

14) Dogs must be leashed during shooting hours. Pets must be attached to one end of the leash and the other end of the leash attached to a fixed object or human.

15) Shooters must present their ATA number to presquad and have all shooters yardages of the posts that are being reserved.

# Follow the Rules to Safely Use Portable Generators

Portable generators can be helpful during an extended power outage. But if not operated properly, you can place yourself as well as line crews from your electric co-op at risk of injury or death.

- Never, ever use a generator indoors—even with windows open—the carbon monoxide can be deadly.
- Use your generator only on a dry surface to avoid the risk of shock.
- Never plug your portable generator into a wall outlet in your home. This produces “backfeeding”—a dangerous risk to the safety of lineworkers.
- Follow the manufacturer’s instructions and safety tips for your generator.
- Plug appliances into the outlet on the generator using only heavy-duty extension cords marked specifically for outdoor use. Check the wattage use of each appliance plugged in and make sure the total does not exceed the cord’s wattage rating. In addition, the cords should have three prongs and should not be frayed or cut.
- Shut down the generator and let it cool down before you refuel—gasoline or kerosene spilled on a hot generator could start a fire.
- If you’re buying your first portable generator, count the wattages for the lighting and appliances—you’ll want to purchase a generator that can handle the load.

#### ATA Trophies and Added Money

All ATA Central Zone residents who compete at any of the shooting locations compete for all trophies and added money provided by the ATA. Any person who wins one of these trophies while shooting at the Stockdale Gun Club (SGC) is still eligible for the SGC trophy in that event. All added money is awarded with trophy. Ties for added money do not divide.

#### Registration Certificate

This certifies that the Stockdale Gun Club has been authorized to hold a registered shoot at Ackley, Iowa on July 28-30, 2017.

#### Qualification Requirements

To assure equitable classification and handicapping, a specific number of targets must be shot in 2015 and 2016 combined with a certain minimum of them being shot in 2016, prior to July 30, 2016

#### PENALTY CLASSES AND HANDICAPS YARDAGE

Those not meeting the target requirements shall be assigned penalty class and yardage as follows.

For women and sub-juniors, the minimum shall be class B singles and Class C in doubles respectively

NOTE: PENALTY YARDAGE WILL BE AS FOLLOWS: YOUR CURRENT ATA ASSIGNED YARDAGE PLUS A MINIMUM OF TWO (2) YARDS TO A MAXIMUM OF 27 YARDS. Example: Shooter A: ATA assigned yardage is 22 yards, plus the two (2) yard penalty; the shooter shoots from the twenty-four (24) yardline. Shooter B; ATA assigned yardage is 26 yards, plus a one (1) yard penalty, shooter shoots from the twenty-seven (27) yardline.

IT IS THE SHOOTERS RESPONSIBILITY TO MAKE SURE THAT ALL SPECIAL CATEGORIES (Lady 1, Lady 2, Sub-juniors, Junior, Junior Gold, Sub Veterans, Veterans, and Senior-Vets must declare their special category at the time of classification in any registered tournament if they wish to compete as a category shooter. Without such declaration, the contestant will not be allowed to compete for the applicable category trophy. No contestant will be allowed to declare or change a special declaration after firing his/her first shot. The only exception to this rule will be to correct an ATA classification error. The following rules apply to shooters who have declared a special category. At all tournaments where All American points will be awarded in any event, shooters may declare only one (1) category (i.e. Lady I, Lady II, Sub Junior, Junior, Junior Gold, Sub Veteran, Veteran, or Senior Veteran) Note: Chair shooters are exempt from this rule.

1. A female shooter, who has not reached her 55th Birthday, may declare Lady I.
2. A female shooter, who has reached her 55th Birthday, may declare Lady II.
3. A shooter who has not reached his/her 15th birthday may declare Sub-Junior.
4. A shooter who is 15 but has not reached his/her 18th birthday may declare as Junior.
5. A shooter who is 18 but has not reached his/her 23rd birthday may declare as Junior Gold.
6. A shooter who is 55 but not reached his/her 65th birthday may declare as a Sub Veteran.
7. A shooter who is 65 but not reached his/her 70th birthday may declare as a Veteran.
8. A shooter who is 70 years of age and older may declare as a Senior Veteran.

## **Effective 18 March 2016, for Satellite Grands and ATA Zone**

### **Shoots:**

All American Points Pins are no longer considered to be trophies by themselves. This means that category shooters who earn a "Pin-Only" award (e.g., 3<sup>rd</sup> Place in the Singles Championship) in their category are eligible to win a class, place, or yardage group trophy.

All shooters, regardless of class, category or yardage group are eligible to win the "Event Champion" All American Points Pin.

Only non-category shooters are eligible to win All American Points Pins for any "Open" place (i.e., R/U – 3<sup>rd</sup> in the Class events, R/U - 5<sup>th</sup> in the Preliminary Handicap, R/U – 4<sup>th</sup> in the Singles and Doubles Championship events, and R/U – 10<sup>th</sup> in the Handicap Championship event).

NOTE: Because of these new rules, in the Class Singles and Doubles events it will be possible for a category shooter to win any of the trophies available since there are no category trophies, only category points pins. Effective 18 March 2015, for Satellite Grands and ATA Zone Shoots:

All American Point pins will be awarded to Zone residents only, and shoot offs or other tiebreakers will be conducted accordingly. The pin awards will be made in addition to any program trophies earned, and are not subject to Rule X, D, 1. These pins are the All-American points' (i.e., NO PIN, NO POINTS).

The only out of zone points awarded will be if shoots or events qualify under "other Major Tournaments" or "Major Event" requirements as listed in the "All-American Team Qualification and Points Awards" addendum section of the rule book.

All-American Points Pins listing is in the Rule Book in the All-American Team addendum mentioned above. The trophy table shown on the website also lists the All-American Points Pins, and a separate tabulation of the all the trophies and pins suitable for printing will be provided by the Zone Administrator.

### **Shoot-Offs/Carry-Overs**

From the ATA Rule Book, page 60:

"In the event that no Trophy is awarded and contestants are eligible and tied for All American Points Pins, ties may be decided by their reverse score on the events in question on full sub events. If ties still exist shoot management may resolve ties by coin flips or other gaming methods. All point pin positions for categories and for open classes will be decided in this way."

The Zone Shoot Administrator will upload the reverse scores and carry over scores necessary to resolve any ties for "points pin only" awards.
